Domestic Use and Distribution

Works (articles, reports, speeches, software, etc.) created by U.S. Government employees are not subject to copyright in the United States, pursuant to 17 U.S.C. § 105. Accordingly, no permission is required, as there is no copyright to either assign or license. Therefore, the Department of Commerce has no objection to the use and/or reproduction and distribution of such works within the United States.

International Copyright

The Commerce Department reserves the right to assert copyright protection internationally, however. To this end, the Department of Commerce hereby grants to the Recipient a royalty-free, nonexclusive license to reproduce and disseminate the Work in all media outside of the United States. Works to be published and/or distributed overseas should bear the following notice: "International copyright, [year], U.S. Department of Commerce, U.S. Government."

Attribution and Disclaimer of Copyright

The Department of Commerce requests that proper attribution is given as to the source of the Work. Therefore, the name of the creator/author of the Work, and the name of the agency should be identified in any publication of the Work. Furthermore, third-parties that wish to make use of U.S. Government works should be aware of the provisions of 17 U.S.C. § 403, in the event that the third-party claims copyright on the subsequent work. Section 403 encourages the Publisher to disclaim any copyright over U.S. Government works that are incorporated into larger works on which copyright is claimed.

Complimentary Copy of Resulting Work

The Department of Commerce further requests, but does not require, that a complimentary copy of any publication of the resulting work be provided to the Department for its use.
